Footnotes

ABSOLUTE ANSWER stalked the pace three wide, bid three deep near the five-sixteenths pole, dueled outside of MANDORLA around the far turn, was under a hold with his head cranked to the right while attempting to lug in throughout the stretch run and prevailed. MANDORLA stalked the pace from the inside, bid two wide between rivals approaching the five-sixteenths pole, dueled inside of the winner from the quarter pole to the wire and just missed. THE PACK IS BACK lacked speed while racing four wide, moved quickly into the contention down the backstretch, lodged a four wide bid into the far turn but could not keep pace with the top two. OUR BAILIWICK lacked speed while racing three wide between rivals, advanced through a tight hole between horses around the far turn, shifted to the far outside in upper stretch and improved his position. CAFE KOMODO dueled two wide through the opening half and faltered. HOLD ON ALLEN dueled along the rail and faltered around the far turn. A. P. CONQUISTADOR was never a factor while racing two wide. GRAND SCIP settled off the pace in the clear in the three path and tired entering the far turn.
