Footnotes

SAGATIBA exchanged bumps after the start, was unhurried while racing four wide around the first two turns, advanced two wide around the far turn, tipped back into the four path nearing the lane, rallied on her left lead, took the lead leaving the sixteenth pole and edged clear late. SHAYLEE'S COMET exchanged bumps with the winner after the start, settled off the pace three wide around the first turn, angled to the rail the first time through the stretch, steadily advanced inside, got through in upper stretch, vied inside of foes in the lane and won the nod for the place. GIRL PRIZE was unprepared for the start, raced three wide around the first turn, angled to the rail the first time through the stretch, advanced inside entering the far turn, swung out leaving the three-sixteenths pole, came seven wide into the lane, rallied outside and just missed second. SHOT GUN MARTY stalked the pace from the rail, bid two wide entering the far turn, vied between rivals and was outfinished. DANCING HOPE disputed the pace three wide around the first turn, cleared the first time through the stretch, set the pace along the rail to upper stretch and weakened. SMART HOKIE saved ground early, raced five wide around the first turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, went three wide around the far turn and faded. TAX OPPONENT hesitated at the start, raced four wide and never threatened. FAST AND FRIENDLY raced four wide around the second turn, saved ground the rest of the way and faded. DEVOUT HOPE raced five wide around the first turn, prompted the pace two wide around the second turn, bumped with DE ALIBI near the seven-sixteenths pole, stopped around the far turn and was easing through the lane. DE ALIBI stalked the pace three and four wide, bumped with DEVOUT HOPE near the seven-sixteenths pole and retreated around the far turn.
