Footnotes

RED HOT AMY, pinched back at the break, settled well back inside, started her advance four wide through the final turn, eased out into the lane and continued to close steadily to get up the final strides. FOLLOW THE WHALES chased the pace off the rail, reached the front nearing the three sixteenths pole, dug in while losing some ground entering the stretch, drifted inward from the sixteenth pole and was outfinished the final strides. BACKSTREET AFFAIR broke inward making contact with Red Hot Amy, was bumped out entering the first turn, settled back toward the outside on the backstretch, bid saving some ground through the final turn and closed well though was impeded late. NICK'S RANSOM rated off the pace off the rail, bid three wide approaching the eighth pole, came inside the drifting Follow The Whales at the top of the stretch then checked when shut off by that one in deep stretch. SHINING CHARLOTTE, off the pace inside, lacked room leaving the turn, angled out toward the sixteenth pole and finished well. COBBLEYS JINGLE settled back toward the outside, started a drive into the final turn but leveled off from the sixteenth pole. MAKIN THE BLUES, off the pace early, bid into the final turn, lacked room at the head of the lane and weakened the remainder. MISS MEADOW was through early. MUCH ADIUÉ came out making contact with Backstreet Affair into the opening turn then never factored. PICK A LADY rated a clear lead inside, was pressured through the final turn and gave way into the lane. After reviewing a claim of foul against the rider of the second place finisher, lodged by the rider of the fourth place finisher, the stewards disqualified the former and placed her fourth for drifting across the path of the latter.
