FORUM TIME unhurried early while inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, altered outside entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and wore down rivals the final furlong. RIGHT LADY stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded entering the drive but could not match strides late. MISS DIXIE DOODLE broke well from the outside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. MAD POET chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward but could not keep pace. BOURBONCOUNTYBLUES could only pass tired ones. JESSANOLDLOVE was no factor. RUSSIAN QUEEN chased the early pace outside and tired. DODGING RAINDROPS was no threat. CAME HOME ITCHY forced the early pace and gave way. HOLY ELEGANCE stumbled at the start and lost irons and was distanced.
