MR. BANDINI'S BAND unhurried early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, dueled through the second turn from the outside, dropped in entering the drive bothering inside rivals, gained the margin and was in time. After a Stewards' Inquiry and Jockey's Objection MR BANDINI'S BAND was disqualified for interference entering the drive. KING HENNY stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, altered outside for the drive, responded and was getting to the winner late. HERO FORCE well placed from between foes early, advanced up the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn, was steadied entering the drive, recovered and finished evenly late. HEAVEN'S RUNWAY broke sharp from between foes to gain the early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, dueled through the second turn, was steadied when MR BANDINI'S BAND came in the tired late. UNBRIDLED'S SCORE chased the early pace inside but had nothing left. BLAZING GRADUATE was never close. SIR YES SIR bobbled at the start, chased the early pace and gave way.
