LE SEUR dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled with FRIEND OF INDY through the drive and outnodded that one at the wire. FRIEND OF INDY dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch with the winner, remained engaged with that one through the stretch but was outnodded in a game effort. LAPILE CREEK stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked but could not keep pace. LUCKY A. C. well placed from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and finished well while no real threat late. JOHN'S BROWN BEAR pressed the early pace from between foes but had nothing left for the drive. FOUR BY FOUR forced the early pace and tired. SIR STAR chased the early pace and tired. OPENING SHOW had little interest. CALCULATED MOVE was never close. APACHE N CO. was finished early.
