COLE'S MAGIC STAR unhurried early from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was just up the final strides. SPECTACULAR SHOT chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, gained a short advantage through the turn, widen the margin to be well clear at the eighth pole but could not last. WILD LUNCH stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. ROGIYA broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but had nothing left. BULIMINELLA GOLD was no real factor. GOLDAFTERNOON well placed from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but flattened out in the drive. JOLIE'S POPPA D pressed the early pace inside and tired. KING SCOTT'S CALL was never close. RODEO TOY chased the early pace inside and gave way. PRIVATE PAPER refused.
