CAPE SAN BLAS stalked the early going from the outside, steadily advanced outside entering the second turn, responded when asked entering the drive, dueled through the drive and was clear late while under steady urging. NATAWAKI dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn but could not match strides through the drive. YUKON BANDIT well placed from the inside early, dropped back up the backstretch, responded to inch closer entering the second turn, made a bid entering the drive and closed well late. MAY SING THE BLUES outrun early, advanced outside up the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn but flattened out in the drive. MANKATO STRIKE could only improve position. COMBUCKSTABLE chased the early pace from the outside, came six wide into the drive and had nothing left. CAT SHOES dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch but tired in the drive. AVA'S WILDCAT dueled from the outside and tired. ALONG THE COAST was five wide throughout and never close.
