B. J.'S LEROI well placed from the outside, dueled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole then was all out to last. LILLIE ABBIE stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked but was outfinished. WHODABABYDADDY dueled for the early lead from the outside, battled up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. LADY O' WAR chased the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded and finished well too late. LEALLAH ANNIE could only improve position. PURA VIDA could only pass tired ones. MY COUSINS AND ME was no factor. BLOOMTOWN BABY dueled from the inside early and had a steady fade. IDE HIT was always outrun.
