FIND THE TIME stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, altered outside, lacked room entering the drive, dropped inside and was just up the final yards. DADDY'S BOY well placed from the inside, advanced entering the turn, altered outside entering the drive but was outfinished. MONTY LIGHTNING up close early from the inside, crept closer entering the turn to duel through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole but was outfinished for the place. KELAMON chased the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded to pressure and was gaining late. MORENO SKY forced the early pace outside and tired. SHERIFF'S BIG GUN broke well from the outside, gained a clear early margin, duelled through the turn then tired in the drive. FORTY WON SMARTS close up from the outside, had nothing left. GORDY BOY was no factor. DARN REY jumped shadows soon after the start and was no threat. WILDCAT'S SLEW up close early, was pulled up entering the turn, bled and was vanned off.
