HIT THE ROAD LEE dueled from the inside early, gained a clear margin entering the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn, continued to be clear at the eighth pole and proved best while kept to task. GET IN DA HOUSE stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked but could not reach the winner. HAZARDS OF LOVE pressed the early pace from the inside, crept closer up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. MR. PORTER far back early, advanced outside, made a bid and finished well but too late. COMMODORE WAY could only improve position. GLORIOUS STRIKE was no factor. BENDANIE was no threat. AND MUSIC CAME forced the early pace outside and gave way.
