Footnotes

CLASSIC LIL HOOVES chased the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked to gain a clear margin mid stretch and was clear late. NATIVE BOY dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive but could not match strides. BUST AND LOOSE stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced up the backstretch, responded and finished well. STRIKE TEN unhurried early, could only improve position. MISTA BAD ATTITUDE was no factor. I'MA DUCK dueled from the inside and tired. RIVER OF ICE was never close. IN SHALLOW WATER was finished after going a half.
