COOPER JAMES chased the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and wore down KILLER the final furlong. KILLER up close early from the outside, dueled up the backstretch, gained a clear margin entering the drive but could not last. CAPOTE'S BOY pressed the early pace from the inside, remained forward entering the second turn but could not keep pace. LOGAN HALL well placed from the inside, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. Z'S COURT could only pass tired ones. LONE STAR SIZZLER broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch then tired. STEWY was no factor. MEB forced the early pace and tired. DOLLAR SIGNS was no threat. HAVEN'S A CALLING was finished early.
