LAYNE'S PAL stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded to duel with ARKOMA through the drive and outnodded that one after a stretch long duel. ARKHOMA chased the early pace from the outside, dueled up the backstretch, remained engaged entering the second turn, battled with the winner but was outnodded. RELENTLESS SLEW stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and was just up for the show. KENSETH chased the early pace from the inside, advanced up the backstretch, responded when asked but was outfinished for the show. RANGE MAN was steadied entering the first turn when in tight, chased the pace from the inside but was no threat late. FLEETWING could only improve position. BIG ROJO broke well from the outside, gained a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch then tired. STORM SNOW had a steady fade. DOSE PLUMAS was no factor. COUSIN KEVIN was no threat.
