Footnotes

SILVER DOLLARDERBY broke well from between foes to gain a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch, shook loose entering the second turn, opened a clear advantage at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. BENDANIE broke in at the start, was unhurried early, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. GRABLETOWN well placed from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn, but was no match while gaining the show. LAKE SYCAMORE forced the early pace from the outside, dueled up the backstretch with the winner, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. NEW YORK PHIL stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, but faltered in the drive. REBEL KING could only improve position. GUARANTEE PLEASURE was no factor. NIGHT HUNTING forced the early pace outside and tired. DOC COLE was no threat. SPRING GULLEY was off a step slow and was never in contention and distanced at the finish.
