STORM BATE outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and closed with a rush to be up the final strides. SPIRIT'S ANGEL stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, gained a short advantage deep stretch but could not last. BEDAZZLE SEATTLE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not match strides. RUSTON RED chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left for the drive. LA BELLE TE FILLE dueled from the inside and tired. SWEET EUGEENA was no factor. STORM KITTY was outrun.
