BEAUDUSA stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded to pressure to gain command, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. OLD ROME chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. CUDA LEE far back early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded and finished well along the rail. IN A RUNAWAY pressed the early pace from the inside, altered outside for the drive and finished well. TOUGH AS NAILS chased the early pace inside but had no late response. LITTLEBITRED was no factor. DILLON'S GOLD IDEA was no threat. WHAT'S UP POP broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch then tired. COMEON HAYNESVILLE had little interest. IDE WHISTLE DIXIE was finished after going a half.
