MARKET MOVER outrun early, advanced outside up the backstretch, circled rivals on the second turn, gained command and was well clear while under steady urging. DOWHATNOW stalked the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the second turn, gained a short advantage but could not match strides. DANCING VALID well placed from the outside, advanced entering the second turn but could only finish even for the show. PRAY TELL pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid and finished well to be even for the show. GETUSUM K. dueled from the inside early, remained engaged up the backstretch and tired. DUSTY TUNNEL forced the early pace outside but had nothing left. PRIETO JOLIE was no factor. TIGER SHARK dueled from the outside and tired. GALLOPING HOME was finished after going a half.
