DORSEY'S DREAM outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered out, bid, brushed with MINED entering the drive, dueled with LIGHTER FLUID through the drive and outfinished that one. LIGHTER FLUID dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, dueled with the winner through the drive but was outnodded. K ONE FOUR pressed the early pace from the inside, dropped back entering the second turn, responded to pressure to come again for the show. LEGACY OF TRUTH far back early, advanced inside, responded when asked and closed well late. MINED dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the second turn, was brushed by the winner entering the drive and tired. REBEL SKY forced the early pace outside but had nothing left. STORMIN BUD was no factor. SHOOT IT'S WAR had a steady fade.
