BLAZING VOW dueled from the outside early, shook loose entering the turn, widen the effort through the drive and was well clear late while never asked. AL'S DREAM far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded but could only gain the place. LAST PRESENT chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, remained forward through the drive but could only hold position. PIDGEONS FLYINPASS dueled from between foes early, held a forward position entering the drive but had no late response. JUST ONCE IDE went evenly. TOUGH POPPA dueled from the inside early, was steadied entering the turn when in tight then went evenly late. FORTY CRIMSONS was no factor. RATE UM SUNNI forced the early pace inside and tired. RUM CAT was always outrun.
