KENAI RIVER unhurried in the beginning, moved up four wide around the final turn, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. RAFFIE'S AIR raced within contention, came around the final turn three wide, entered the stretch five wide and proved third best. VIRGIL Q raced within striking distance and lacked a late bid. TOTAL DEMAND broke sharp, eased back and was no threat late. BOLD LOUISA'S BOY broke in, went to the front, stopped and was distanced.
