RAINDROPSAFALLING dueled from the outside early, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the second turn, responded when challenged entering the drive and held sway. GIRLIE GO steadied early when in tight, stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked and was gaining late. BURNINGRICH well placed from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail but flattened out late. NET'S ALL N pressed the early pace from the outside, remained forward but could not keep pace. NO ORDINARY GIRL could only improve position. DREAMSALIVE could only pass tired ones. I. M. A. GIFT was no factor. MAMI WATA was never close. TRIBUTE'S FLAME had a steady fade. TRICKYBELL was finished after a half.
