BROADWAY KING dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive and was all out late to last. SIMPLY BODACIOUS stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded entering the drive along the rail but was outnodded in a game effort. SHAWNA'S TOUGH POP dueled from the outside early, battled through the turn, remained engaged entering the drive but could not keep pace. KNOCKYA LIGHTS OUT outrun early, advanced inside entering the drive, responded and closed well but too late. RED RIVER MT. forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. HUFFS MR. BIGGS was no factor. T HALL was no threat. JETTIN CASCADE was never close.
