BEE'S BUCKAROO stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, gained the advantage entering the drive and was well clear while under steady urging. INQUISIT up close early from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. LITTLEBITYRED unhurried early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the show. FIRST DOWN CORY forced the early pace outside, made a bid entering the drive and finished well. LIL FORTY up close early from the inside, had nothing left. BIG BOY ROY broke sharp from the inside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch then tired in the drive. REMEMBER HOAGY was no factor. GETTIN WESTERN chased the early pace and tired. MR STOTT was no threat. MR. MICHAEL J was no menace.
