PROMISETOMAKE IT stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, responded to pressure and wore down CHAD BE GLAD the final furlong. CHAD BE GLAD dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn, held a short margin at the eighth pole but could only just last for the place. RED VENTURE unhurried early from the inside, advanced inside entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail and had good energy late. CHEF SCOTT chased the early pace from between foes, remained in a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. ARCTIC COMET allowed to settle early, advanced outside but was no real threat late. BEGBIE could only pass tired ones. TWIN CITY THUNDER chased the early pace inside and tired. GEAX REAUX GEAX dueled from the inside and tired. DEPUTY RED bobbled at the start and was no factor. STORM TAMER had a steady fade.
