FINE N ADORABLE dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, shook loose at the eighth pole and held sway. CHOCOLATE BOY chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded when asked and was getting to the winner. SMOKIN' ROADSTER up close early from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. TRIBUTE OF GOLD pressed the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, came six wide into the drive and finished well. GOODIFITGOES dueled from the outside early, battled up the backstretch then tired in the drive. ROMAN DECISION chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. J. P.'S BELLE was no factor. SILVER BLADE bobbled at the start and showed little. KEAT KENNEDY was always outrun.
