KIM'S WINENROSES chased the early pace from the outside, inched forward entering the second turn to challenge the winner but could not match strides. MISS MARGROCK stalked the earl pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded but was outfinished for the place. KISSAME BREEZE forced the early pace from the outside but could not keep pace. LEE'S ANGEL pressed the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. JAKE'S TUITION chased the early pace from the inside but had no late response. FARCE IDE was never close. JADESEYE showed little. ZIVA D. chased the early pace from the inside but stopped in the drive.
