**Footnotes**

IMA CHU CHU TRAIN stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, awaited room entering the drive, dropped to the rail upper stretch, brushed with THE DIVINE TUNNEL mid stretch and was up in time. THE DIVINE TUNNEL broke well from the outside to gain a short early margin, opened a clear advantage up the backstretch, duelled through the drive, brushed with the winner mid stretch and was outfinished late. STRAIGHT FLASH unhurried early while outside rivals, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, responded entering the second turn, came six wide into the drive and was gaining late. STRICTLY WOOD chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid but flattened out in the drive. FINE STORM forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the drive but tired late. A J'S FASHION could only pass tired ones. CATOFNINELINES was no factor. GENO flashed early speed and tired. UNBRIDLED BRICK was never close. KISATCHIE RUN forced the early pace outside and stopped.
