LONE STAR QUEST stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was along in time. MISS LUCKY SLEW well placed from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, responded along the rail but just missed. R. V. INGWITH MARV broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. SHAKEM N BREAKEM forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. SIMIPRIVATE chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn but had not late response. MISS DEALBREAKER could only pass tired ones. CARONELLA was no factor. KAY I'M HOME was no threat. HOOPA chased the early pace and gave way. WERBLIN PHONE pressed the early pace from between foes, was steadied entering the turn when in tight and tired.
