MAMA'S QUEEN far back early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was along in time. DOUBLE DARE YA outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and was just up for the place. THE HOUSE OF ROME dueled from the outside for the early margin, remained engaged up the backstretch, gained a clear margin entering the second turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole, ducked in deep stretch and was outfinished for the place. SO MARY pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid and finished well too late. OLIVIA'S MAGICSTAR dueled from the inside and tired. STORMIN LEAKY pressed the early pace and tired. RAILING CIGAR forced the pace and tired. PETITE DOT NOIR had a steady fade. LADY DOW showed little.
