DADDY WARBUCKS vied for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout, raced between rivals around the turn, brushed down the stretch with WHO LET THE CAT IN, dueled to the wire and proved the best. WHO LET THE CAT IN pressed the pace, moved up three wide around the final turn, brushed down the stretch, dueled and was outfinished for the win. FORTUNE'S PRAISE challenged for the early lead, saved ground around the second turn and couldn't keep up late with the top two. I SPY WOLFIE pressed the pace, raced outside around the final turn and lacked a late kick. SAMMY FROM MIAMI lacked early speed, saved ground and lacked a bid. CAPTAIN ABOVE void of early speed, raced four wide around both turns and showed little.
