PHONE MARYBE chased the early pace from the inside, altered outside entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was well clear while never asked. AUBREY'S WALK far back early, advanced inside entering the turn, made a bid along the rail but could only gain the place. BABY REESE stalked the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly entering the turn, responded along the rail and finished well. KRISTYS XPECTATION pressed the early pace from the inside but could only improve position. PHU BIRD chased the early pace and tired. HUNG UP forced the early pace and tired. QUADRIGA broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, dueled through the turn but gave way. TAPITFORPAR was never close and was pulled up entering the turn and walked off.
