ST. ARIAN chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was up the final strides. TRIPLE HIT dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, gained a clear margin entering the drive but could not last. KEEP ON SMOKIN dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch, remained forward but could not keep pace. PRADO'S MAIN MAN outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and finished well. HIT THE SWITCH chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. OVERNIGHT FLIGHT was no factor. NICENE CREED chased the early pace inside and tired. SEEKINGACURE was no threat.
