SLOW WALKIN' JOHN raced within striking distance, moved up on the inside around the final turn, angled out and drove clear down the stretch. ALBERT'S GIFT lacked early speed, made a late gain and finished willingly. DANSLUCKYCHARM had a tight start, raced in the rear, moved up, rallied down the lane, split rivals and closed well. LE FLORE went to the front, drove clear and hung down the stretch. RENO BOB broke in, raced near the back, moved up five wide around the final turn, but was no factor. CZARB raced in the middle of the field, came around the first turn five wide and finished evenly. PRIVATE CHERRY raced near the middle of the field, came around the final turn four wide and weakened. FAST FASHION was an early factor, then dropped back. BELIEVE N SOMETHIN pressed the early pace and retreated to the rear.
