Footnotes

HONEY DEW dueled from the inside for the early lead, shook loose up the backstretch, held a clear margin entering the second turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. BECAUSE I SAID well placed from the inside, remained closest to the leader entering the second turn but was no match while clearly second best. SAPPHIRE STRIKE stalked the early pace from the inside, altered outside up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn but could only gain the show. IMAGINE I'M EASY chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid but could only improve position. MYLITTLE CHER AMIO chased the early pace but had nothing left for the drive. GOTTA HAVE HOPE could only pass tired ones. FORTY WINS was no factor. ABASTADA pressed the early pace and tired. PRINCESS TATUM had a steady fade. SUKEY TAWDRY was never close.
