AMERICAN EFFECT dueled from the inside for the early lead, opened a clear margin entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and was well clear late while under steady urging. HUFFS MR. BIGGS far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded when asked and closed well late. DADDY'S BOY chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded along the rail but was outfinished for the place. BRYSON'S COMET forced the early going from the outside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. MY GENIUS FRIEND pressed the early pace from the outside but was no threat late. WILDCAT CHARMS could only pass tired ones. BUDDY'S MAN was never close. ROANA'S ROAR dueled from the outside and tired. BILLY BO had steady fade. SHARIR was no threat.
