RAILROAD SHOW well placed from the outside early, crept closer entering the second turn, reached a striking position entering the drive, split rivals mid stretch and was just up late. MR LANGLEY dueled from the outside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the drive but was outfinished. TEMPT stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn, dueled through the drive but was outfinished. WELL'S GOLD chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded but was too late. JORDON BE FAST could only improve position. SUESTAMER went evenly. SHOUTFORJOY up close early from the inside, tired in the drive. COOL BAY dueled from the inside and tired. KING OSCAR was never close. A TARA IN THE SKY showed little.
