FIERY CHOICE stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and steadily drew clear. LOGAN'S PRIZE well placed from the inside, altered outside entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. GOODBYE EXCAVATE dueled from between foes early, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn but could not match strides. PROLONGED dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. ASHAR MAN raced evenly. SUGAR BOWL DAY was no threat. VIVA LAS ANGEL was no factor. EXCESSIVE DIAMONDS chased the early pace and tired. BONZAWAY dueled from the inside and gave way. I'D BE A SECRET was never close.
