CRISTATA outrun for three quarters, advanced between foes on the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was clear late under steady urging. CHANGING STORM stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, made a bid to gain a short advantage at the eighth pole but could not keep pace. NICODEMUS well placed from between foes early, made a bid entering the second turn but could not keep pace. SWEET DIXIELAND unhurried early, advanced inside, made a bid and finished well. ADDICTED BAY could only improve position. PEANUT TWO broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch and tired. HARD TO TWIST was no factor. RED HOT HALO dueled from the outside and tired. HAVE A GOOD DAY chased the pace from the outside and gave way.
