ALL THINGS GOLD broke sharp from between foes to gain the early margin, remained clear entering the turn, held a clear advantage at the eighth pole and held sway. SIMPLY BODACIOUS chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not reach the winner. STORM SNOW stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded and closed well late. FIND THE TIME forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward but had nothing left. KNOCKYA LIGHTS OUT could only improve position. SHAWNA'S TOUGH POP was no factor. CONTROVERSIAL was no threat. RED RIVER MT. chased the early pace and tired. DOUBLE EDGE STORM was finished early.
