WHAT'S UP POP dueled from the inside for the early lead, shook loose entering the turn, widen the advantage at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. BUCKLE DOWN well placed from the inside, early, dueled with the winner, held a forward position entering the turn, but was no match while holding the place. HIT THE SWITCH stalked the early pace from the outside, dropped inside entering the turn, responded and was gaining late. DEPUTY SOLDIER forced the early pace from the inside but could only improve position. NEWYORKJOE pressed the early pace inside and tired. STORM SNOW was no factor. TIME FOR TROUBLE chased the early pace outside and tired. RUTTLES showed little.
