STRONG AND TOUGH stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, made a bid mid turn, dueled through the drive and inched clear late. IMA SMASH OAK well placed from the outside, advanced entering the turn, made a bid and was gaining late. SIDE'S SONG dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up entering the turn, battled through the drive but could not match strides. ALONG THE COAST dueled from the inside early, remained forward through the turn but could not keep pace. IDE WHISTLE DIXIE well placed from between foes, remained in a striking position entering the drive but could only go evenly late. BAD FOOTED GRADY dueled from between foes early, remained engaged through the turn but tired in the drive. ROMAN DECISION went evenly. SILVER PATRIOT was no factor. BAGDAD TIGER was no threat. WHO DAT NATION hesitated at the start and was outrun.
