IDE BE A STAR stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded and finished even for the win. KEATS ROYAL TIME pressed the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure and finished even for the win. LEE'S CHAMP well placed from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked but

flattened out late. SEE THE STREAM dueled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, remained clear at the eighth pole but weakened late. ZEALUNAR could only improve position. ANGEL FISH could only pass tired ones. LOUISIANA LIGHT was no factor. TRIBUTE'S PASSION dueled from the outside and tired. KENZIE'S A DEELITE chased the early pace and tired. STORM GIRLS DO was finished after going a half.
