FIRST GOLD broke sharp from the outside to gain the early margin, widen the effort up the backstretch, remained well clear entering the drive and was clear late while kept to task. TENURE stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced outside, made a bid but could not reach the winner. DORSEY'S DREAM outrun early, advanced outside, made a bid and closed well late. SIERRA MAESTRA chased the early pace from between foes, remained forward through the drive but could not keep pace. KNOCK well placed from the inside, could only improve position. HACKBERRY pressed the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but flattened out late. EARTHQUAKE was no factor. CLASSIC LIL HOOVES chased the early pace inside and tired. NOCHANGENWEATHER had a steady fade and was eased to the wire.
