**Footnotes**

ESKIMO BLIZZARD stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, dueled with RARE LUKEY through the drive and was clear late. RARE LUKEY broke sharp from the inside to gain the early margin, dueled up the backstretch with WHAT RAGE, put that one away entering the second turn, was engaged by the winner entering the drive and could not match strides. SERPENTINE well placed from the outside, held a forward position entering the second turn, dropped back entering the drive, responded and came again but too late. DOLLAR FACTOR forced the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive and finished well. TWO CROWNS could only pass tired ones. ONE CREW could only improve position. WHAT RAGE chased the early pace outside and tired. BURNIN N TURNIN had a steady fade. ROUGHHOUSE was never close. QUICK SCORE chased the early pace outside and gave way.
