IDE BETTER WIN far back early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and found his best stride in time. MATTGETSNORESPECT forced the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked to gain a short advantage deep stretch but was outfinished. STRIKE IT dueled from the outside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn but could not keep pace. LE SEUR dueled from the inside early, battled up the backstretch, fought through the second turn but tired late. FLYING IDE went evenly. COUPLE OF HOURS was no threat. IT'S NO SECRET was never close. CHOCTAW PRINCE was always outrun.
