BONNE WON dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. BON TON ROULET dueled from the inside early, battled up the backstretch, remained in a forward position entering the drive but could not match strides. HEY PODZ chased the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn but could not keep pace through the drive. RACETRACK ROMEO stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, made a bid and finished well but too late. LITTLEBITRED well placed from the inside, had nothing left for the drive. WHAT A TRIBUTE forced the early pace and tired. ROCKET TO THE SKY was no factor. MILLER GROVE was no threat. ALONG CAME JOHN had little interest. OKAY LEE showed little.
