IMONONE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, shook loose entering the second turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was well clear while under steady urging. TEMPT dueled from between foes for the early lead, battled up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive but was no match late while holding position. SPARKS TO FLAME outran early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded when asked but could only gain the show. AWAYFROMITALL chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the second turn but flattened out in the drive. FORTY WON SMARTS forced the early pace from the inside but had no late response. MR LANGLEY dueled from the inside and tired. KING A SOBIE was no factor. FOUR STAR PLAYER was no threat. FRIENDLY FALCON was never close.
