Footnotes

GENUINE GIRL tracked the leaders racing off the rail into the backstretch, advanced steadily on the first flight nearing the far turn, swung out to challenge four wide midway through that bend, forged clear into the lane and widened under pressure. THE GOODBYE GIRL angled to the rail soon after the start and stalked the leaders in that path to the far turn, made some progress to secure the place in the drive but was no match. SASSY SECRET, void of early speed, saved ground to the lane and improved position in late stages. LILBITOFATTITUDE forced the pace between foes for five furlongs, then emptied out on far turn. MACOUPIN CREEK tracked the leaders on the inside to the far turn but never seriously menaced. TYPHOON TAFFY, prominent along the inside to the backstretch, dropped off the leaders leaving the first turn between calls, responded to pressure and forced the pace into the far turn, then gave way entering that bend. SURE SHOT LOU vied three wide between foes for a half and abruptly gave way. CACHE pressed the pace four wide into the backstretch and soon gave way. SETDUTCHESSFREE was allowed to settle and never threatened.
