AMAZING SAINT chased the early pace from the outside, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded to pressure to gain the margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. G RATED dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the drive, held a forward position entering the stretch, drifted in slightly mid stretch and was no match late. After a Jockey's Objection there was no change. RUBY'S BIG BAND pressed the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail, was steadied mid stretch then went evenly late. LADY TAMER dueled from the outside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, remained forward but tired in the drive. JILL MARIE trailed throughout.
